



# Swisscom mobile phone service offer for refugees fleeing the war in Ukraine

Swisscom is supporting refugees from Ukraine. We have created this offer to help them stay in touch with relatives and friends.

## Who is this offer intended for?

For refugees fleeing the war in Ukraine who are staying in Switzerland and who have a Permit S or have applied for one.

Maximum 1 SIM card per person is allowed. There is no entitlement to obtain this offer.

## What does the offer include?

- Internet within CH: unlimited (60 GB high speed)
- Calls within CH and to UKR: 900 mins/30 days, then CHF 0.10/min
- Calls from CH to other countries: 90 mins/30 days, then Standard tariff
- SMS: 900 messages
- Roaming: Standard tariff
- Starting balance: CHF 20.– (one-off charge)
- Activation fee: CHF 0.–

**Price: CHF 0.– per month**

## Duration of the offer

The offer will remain valid until further notice. Swisscom is entitled to change or discontinue the offer at any time without notice and without giving reasons. Any changes will be announced by Swisscom via SMS.
